Subject : Academic Guidelines for School Year 2019 - 2020

Greetings of Faith and Hope to everyone!

Our government has declared an extension of the Enhanced Community Quarantine (ECQ) in the National Capital Region (NCR) until May 15, 2020 to contain the spread of the COVID-19. Thus, normalcy is still far from over.

As we continue to give premium to health safety of everyone especially the vulnerable including children, the Vincentian Mission Team (VMT) approved the following guidelines relative to the academic concerns for School Year 2019 - 2020:

- 1.) Following the school calendar submitted to DepEd, the School Year 2019 2020 shall end by May 12, 2020 for Kindergarten to Grade 10 and May 13, 2020 for Senior High School on online mode.
- 2.) Because of the Enhanced Community Quarantine (ECQ), students have been given learning tasks by their respective teachers from March 16 to April 17, 2020 via email or group chat. Learning tasks are based on essential learning competencies of the Fourth Quarter. Learning outputs during ECQ are part of the Fourth Quarter Grade computation.
- 3.) Students who were not able to comply with the online activities because of unavailable resources and internet access can still submit their requirements to Concordia College after the ECQ through delivery services like Grab, LBC and the like. Deadline of submission of requirements will be until May 30, 2020.
- 4.) Computation of grades for the fourth quarter will be based on the DepEd Memorandum No. 42, s. 2020, **Guidelines for the Remainder of School Year 2019 2020 in Light of Covid-19 Measures.** Thus, the school will adopt the grading and transmutation formula for the evaluation of the final grades for the fourth quarter specified in paragraph 5.
- 5.) Since the Inter Agency Task Force (IATF) for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases imposed strictly social distancing as one of the preventive measures for the spread of COVID 19, the Moving up Ceremony of the Kindergarten, Grades 6 and 10 and Recognition will be cancelled. Graduation for Senior High School students will be based on the result of the survey that will be given to the parents if they will be amenable with an August or September graduation rites.
- 6.) Proposed opening of the School Year 2020 2021 is on August 11, 2020. This proposal is subject to change depending upon the final directive that will be set forth by the Department of Education (DepEd) and the recommendations that will be released by the Inter Agency Task Force (IATF).
